At SRMS, 739 pupils get scholarshipss

Bareilly: As many as 739 students received scholarship worth Rs 3 crore at Sri Ram Murti Smarak (SMRS) Institution of Medical Sciences on Tuesday.

On Tuesday, the colleges under SRMS trust observed the birth anniversaries of Mahatma Gandhi and Lal Bahadur Shastri, and hoisted national flags. Dev Murti, chairman, SRMS Trust, inaugurated a blood donation camp at SRMS Institution of Medical Sciences in Bareilly, where 76 people donated blood. SRMS trust also observed the 30th death anniversary of Shri Ram Murti, a freedom fighter and former minister and ex-MP, and paid homage to him. On the occasion, the SRMS trust provided scholarships

worth Rs 3 crore to 739 students.

Dev Murti said, "There is a need to have coordination between educational institutes and the industries. It's difficult when an institute is affiliated to a government university. Hence, we have sent a proposal to the government for setting up of SRMS University. Our trust is in the process of establishing innovation and incubation cell and think lab. Heal and Care, Step 2 Life (Rehabilitation centre) will become functional in December in Lucknow, while a hospital is proposed to become functional in Lucknow's Arjunganj by February 2020. A palliative ward and nursing and paramedical college are proposed in Unnao." TNN
