## Latest Update

Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar elected 14th Vice President of India



NDA candidate Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar was elected as the 14th Vice President of India. Shri Dhankhar defeated joint Opposition candidate Margaret Alva. Shri Dhankhar, who is a former governor of West Bengal, secured 528 votes while 80year-old Alva got 182. The winner of this election is Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar who replaced Shri Venkaiah Naidu as Vice President on 11 August 2022.

## **Common Wealth Games 2022**

It was the largest ever in the history of the games with 5,054 athletes from 72 nations competing in 280 events in 20 sports from July 29 to August 8. India got the fourth position in the medals tally, despite shooting, India's most successful sport at the CWG, not being a part this time.

India has won 61 medals - 22 gold, 16 silver and 23 bronze medals. For the first time ever in CWG history, the para-sports medals section was also clubbed alongside the overall medal table for every nation. One great aspect of India's great showing at CWG 2022 is the incredible performance by their women athletes. Of the total 22 gold medals won by India, eight were won exclusively by women.

BILLIONAIRE stock investor and founder of the country's newest airline Akasa Air, Rakesh Jhunjhunwala, passed away

BILLIONAIRE stock investor and founder of the country's newest airline Akasa Air, Rakesh Jhunjhunwala, passed away. He was 62. Rakesh Jhunjhunwala, also known as 'India's Warren Buffett'. Jhunjhunwala died of sudden cardiac arrest. Born on July 5, 1960, Jhunjhunwala studied and trained to be a chartered accountant; and his investment since the mid-1980s have grown to \$5.8 billion or Rs 46,000 crore as of August 2022.

Akasa had its inaugural flight from Mumbai to Ahmedabad just a week ago on August 7. Other than Akasa Air that he founded recently, Jhunjhunwala is also a promoter of Star Health and Allied Insurance, he with his wife together holding a 17.49 per cent stake in the company. The couple holds 5.05 per cent in Titan, 5.48 per cent in Crisil and 3.64 per cent in Federal Bank. His other big investment holdings include Titan Company, where he along with his wife Rekha held 5.05 per cent stake. He owns 1.09 per cent stake in Tata Motors.

## Indians are finally ready to pay more for planet-friendly consumer brands.

A new survey by Bain & Company said 52% of consumers in urban India expect to increase spending on sustainable brands in the next three years.

The consultancy, which surveyed consumers on their outlook toward sustainable brands and their buying habits, said over 60% of consumers in India are willing to pay a premium for 'sustainability products'. In the survey, 20% of consumers said they are environmentally and socially conscious while 49% said they are health conscious. Sustainability is equally important across age and income groups, the firm said in its APAC Sustainability Report.

& surveyed Bain Company 1,550 consumers in India seeking comments from gen Z, millennials, gen X and boomers. As many as 80% of respondents represented the top 60 percentile of income levels, while 46% of respondents ranged between 40-80 percentile, while 90% were from urban areas. In the APAC region, it surveyed over 16,000 respondents. "While one may have expected that consumers identifying as either environmentally or socially conscious and health conscious would have predominance in certain subsections of the society, the fact is that it is equally prevalent across income, age and gender."
