RULES AND REGULATION OF ZEST AND AAMOD

- Travelling expenses of the participating teams will be borne by the team/participants itself.
- All the teams are required to confirm their arrival time and place, well in advance, so that they can be received by the volunteers of SRMS.
- Registration fee would be Rs. 200 per candidate and Rs. 50 per candidate as caution money. This caution money would be refundable.
- Faculty members accompanying the team will not be charged any fee subject to a maximum of two.
- Boarding and lodging would be provided only to the registered members and accompanying faculty members.
- Nobody would be allowed to participate in more than 3 events under any circumstances. If somebody is found violating this rule his/her candidature would be cancelled from ZEST.
- No external participation will be allowed in Renaissance.
- No cameras would be allowed. There will be an official photographer who can be contacted for special snaps if needed.
- Decision of the judges would be final for all events.
- Any event can be deleted or added without any prior notice.
- Outside faculty members may be invited for judgment.
- Registration for any event will stop one hour before the event.
- All the participants are requested to bring their identity cards and the letter of approval from their college authority.

- Participants only from B.Tech., B.Pharma, MBA, PGDM, M.Tech, M.Pharma, MCA and Medical (MBBS & BDS) courses will be entertained.
- In cases of shortage of time, the registration for any event will be done on first come first serve basis.
- The students from all participating colleges will be allowed to participate in the respective events only after one hour of their registration.

Any of the events, such as dramatics, mimicry etc should not depict anything which may be derogatory or may hurt the sentiments of any religion, community, institution or an individual. Any such depiction will result in cancellation of the registration.

- The following props should not be used in any event: real cigarettes, real knives, guns, liquor, crackers or any other indecent or dangerous material.
- Participation is open for Zest and Aamod.
- Smoking and drinking is strictly prohibited in the campus.
- Only participants are allowed for zest and aamod. Viewers are not allowed.
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<u>RULES FOR PARTCIPATION OF ZEST AND AAMOD</u>

• Top body of TYRO/VERVE including President, Vice-President and Secretary can participate in any 2 events of ZEST & AAMOD each.

- Treasurer and all Organizing Secretaries of TYRO/VERVE can participate in total 2 events including ZEST and AAMOD each.
- All Chairpersons can participate in total 2 events including 1 event of their respective club (including Judgement Chairpersons) in zest and aamod each.
- Head Co-ordinators can participate in 2 events of ZEST & AAMOD each including 1 event of their respective committee.

Committee Co-ordinators can participate in 3 events of ZEST & AAMOD each including 2 event of their respective committee.

- TYRO/VERVE Executives can participate in 3 events of ZEST & AAMOD each.
- Organizers and volunteers of different committee can participate in any 3 events of Zest and Aamod each.

<u>RULES FOR MEMBERS OF JUDGEMENT COMMITTEE</u>

- Volunteers & Organisers of Judgement committee can participate in total 3 events of ZEST & AAMOD each.
- Co-ordinators of Judgement committee can participate in 2 events ZEST & AAMOD each. JC members are not allowed to participate in events in which they are judging.
- There is no limit of participation in events of Informals Committee.

<u>DANCE</u>

(a) <u>CENTRIFUGE (INDIAN GROUP DANCE</u>)

- Number of participants in a group should be between 10 to 30.
- Song(s) should be from Indian movie, beats, I two other songs either album or Punjabi. Although songs for fillers/ punch lines can be of any origin.
- Mixing of song is allowed.
- Props in clothing are allowed (no liquids & sprays).
- Props that can cause any danger are strictly prohibited (e.g. Metal, sticks & rods).
- There will be only one round: Time is 7:30 to 9:30 minutes.
- Minimum 5 members should be on stage throughout the performance.
- Projectors are not allowed.

(6). SHAKE A LEG (SOLO DANCE (BOYS & GIRLS))

- There will be one round in solo dance.
- Song should be from an Indian movie, album or Hollywood songs.

- Time limit: 2:00 to 3:00 minutes.
- Any song as per the participant's choice.
- Fusion is allowed.
- Vulgar songs are not allowed.

(c). TWO FOR A TANGO (DUET DANCE: (BOYS & GIRLS COMBINED))

- Two members at the time of performance.
- Time limit is 2 to 3 minutes.
- Song selection as per participant choice. (Hindi, album songs, beats).
- Fusion is allowed.
- Props are allowed (Props that can cause any danger are strictly prohibited).
- No vulgar songs.

(d) <u>BEST DANCER (BOYS & GIRLS COMBINED)</u>

- Participants have to perform on following three different style of songs :
 - Indian
 - Folk(Boys) & Classical(Girls)
 - Western(may be beats)
- All the three style songs will be played on the spot.
- *Props are not allowed.*
- Each song of three style will be played for atleast one minute.

(e) FACE-OFF (STEP-UP)

- No props are allowed.
- Songs can be Hindi or Punjabi.
- Time limit 2 to 3 minutes.
- Songs will be played on the spot.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- Maximum time limit for solo and duet event will depend upon the number of external participants and the time allotted to the event at the time of execution.
- Participants must bring their songs in a pen drive only. The malfunctioning of pen drive will not be under committee's responsibility.
- Only 1 entry of the invited colleges will allowed to participate in every group event.
- At most 2 entries will be entertained in solo events of the invited colleges.
- Number of participants will be decided on the basis of time or on First come First Serve Basis.

DRAMA (MIRROR OF LIFE)

<u>a) MULTISCENE</u>

• Each team should have a maximum of 25 members.

- Maximum time is 20 minutes (curtain to curtain) and minimum time is 12 minutes (excluding set-up time).
- Team is free to choose the theme on its own.
- Drama can be bilingual.
- There should be more than one scene.
- Background music is allowed.
- Props are allowed and the participants have to arrange them themselves.

<u>b</u>) <u>ONE ACT</u>

- Each team should have a maximum of 15 members.
- Maximum time is 15 minutes and minimum time is 8 minutes (excluding setup).
- Team is free to choose the theme on its own.
- Only Hindi play is allowed.
- The scene should not change in any case and scene should be only of one place only.
- Background music is allowed.
- Props are allowed and the participants themselves should arrange them.

<u>c)</u> <u>STREET PLAY</u>

- Each team of maximum 15 members.
- Time limit is 8 minutes to 15 minutes.
- No music support.
- For props only dupatta, hand-made posters , calling bells.
- Uniformity in dress is required.

<u>d) VISMRITI (MIME)</u>

- There should be a maximum of 15 members.
- Time limit is 7 to 12 minutes.
- Touching is allowed but no lip-sync.
- Background sound/music is allowed.
- Face color variations are allowed.

e) I, ME, MYSELF (MONO-ACTING)

- Only one participant will be on test.
- Time limit is 4:30 minutes (thinking-1:30minutes, performance -2 to 3 minutes (not less than 2 minutes and not more than 3 minutes)).
- *Props are not allowed.*
- Background sound/music is not allowed.

<u>f</u>) <u>MOVIE SPOOF</u>

- Team of maximum 15 members is allowed.
- Time limit is 8 to 15 minutes (including setup time).
- Props are allowed and the participants have to arrange them themselves.
- Script should be based upon one or more movies, series, advertisements, news, channels, etc.
- Background sounds are allowed.

OTHER RULES

- Dramatics committee will only provide chairs, one table, Cordless mikes, hanging mikes, collar mikes(depending upon availability). All other props have to be brought by teams. The committee depending upon the availability and on prenotification by the team will fulfill any other special requirement.
- Arena boundations will be decided and defined by the chairperson (according to the place of act) before the events to each and every group.
- Team exceeding the time limit will be penalized. (Negative marking will be there).
- Backstage voice of a participant will be considered as a participation of that member in the team.
- Script (basic theme) can't be changed in the final performance at Zest 2014, otherwise team will be disqualified.
- Any type of script, formation used in screening by any drama team should not be imitated by any other team .Copyright of any such thing will be provided by the Judgement committee.
- For the achievement of best team, drama king, drama queen, the required marking scheme can be taken from dramatics coordinators.

FINE ARTS COMMITTEE

<u>a) GRATIS (HANDFREE PAINTING)</u>

- Team of two members.
- Time Limit 30 minutes.
- Theme Based.
- Participants can use their environment.
- A4 size paper and poster colour will be provided.

<u>b) CHARCOLATE</u> (CHARCOAL SKETCHING)(Individual)

- Time Limit 30 minutes.
- Theme Based.
- Charcoals lead & A4 sheets will be provided.

<u>c) TEE-SPLASH(T-SHIRT PAINTING</u>)

- Team of two member.
- Colors and T-shirt will be provided.
- Theme Based.
- Further Rules on spot.

d)PAINT A SPOT (SELFIE POINT)

- Team event of 8 to 12 members.
- Chart paper, thermacol, ribbon and colours will be provided.
- Teams can also use their own decorative items.

e)CARTOONING

- Time limit 30 minutes.
- *Rules on the spot.*

- Theme based.
- Requirements (A4 sheets, Pencil, eraser, sharpener, black sketch pen) will be provided.

<u>f)ORIGAMI (PAPER CUTTING)</u>

- Theme based event of duration 30 minutes.
- Team event of two members.

Note: Contestants have to bring their own pair of scissors and other requirements.

<u>a) HYSTERIA (INDIAN SOLO)</u>

- Only Hindi songs are allowed.

- Male Female constraints are not compulsory.
- No written material will be allowed during competition.
- Instrumental backtrack is allowed.

\underline{d} \underline{DUET}

- Only Hindi songs are allowed.
- 2 to 4 min.
- Male-Female constraints not compulsory.
- Song should not be necessarily a duet song.
- No written material is allowed during competition.
- Instruments are not allowed.

- Merit certificate and medal will be awarded in athletics up to third position.
- Best player (Men & Women) will be awarded with a special prize and trophy.
- Photograph of all matches will be taken by professionals out station teams can get their photographs.
- Wide press coverage by local channels and newspapers.
- If any event does not fulfill the minimum criteria, the event will be cancelled.
