As per CPCB new guideline for prevention of spreading COVID-19

1. COVID-19 BIOMEDICAL WASTE

A) Isolation Ward:-

- Keep separate color code bins (With foot lids) bags/containers in Isolation ward
- Items like left over food, disposable plates, glass, use masks, used tissues, used toiletries, etc used by COVID-19 patient shall become biomedical waste and shall be segregated in yellow bags.
- Used gloves and plastic bottle from patients will be disposed off in red bag.

- Used gloves and plastic bottle from patients will be disposed off in red bag.
