### Our Inspiration

**Late Ram Murti Ji** 08.02.1910 - 02.10.1988

he SRMS Trust was established in the memory of Late Shri Ram Murti Ji, veteran freedom fighter, a true Gandhian, Ex-Parliamentarian and Ex-Minister, U.P. Govt.

Shri Ram Murti Ji was born on February 08, 1910 in a renowned zamindar family from the lineage of Sahu Thakur Dass at village Dhaura of District Bareilly. After attaining the basic education from Bareilly, he completed graduation from Banaras Hindu University and thereafter did Post Graduation and LL.B. from Lucknow University.

Being impressed with the philosophy of Gandhi Ji and inspired by the thoughts of Mahamana Pt. Madam Mohan Malviya he courted arrest while studying in Banaras Hindu University. He took part in all Satyagrahs and Quit India Movement launched by AICC under the mature and dynamic leadership of Gandhi Ji. He was a true Gandhian. He was imprisoned several times during freedom struggle and was sentenced Kal Kothri for two months.

Shri Ram Murti Ji declined to accept the pension offered to the freedom fighters, since he was of the conviction that whatever he did for the mother land was out of patriotism and not for material gains. In pursuance of the same spirit he donated 30 acres of agricultural land in the Bhoodan Movement of Late Shri Vinoba Bhabhe.

He breathed last on October 02, 1988.



#### (I) SOCIAL ENDEAVOR

#### **Charitable Health Care Services**

SRMS Hospital On Wheel – Mobile hospital is reaching in rural areas with the objective to provide Screening & Treatment facilities at the door step for Blindness, Deafness, Diabetes, T.B., Malnutrition, Hypertension, Cancer & support services for Healthy Mother & Healthy Baby. Free diagnostics, free medicines and consultation of doctors are being provided. This facility was inaugurated by then Honorable Chief Minister of UP. Till now, 87500 patients have been benefitted by this initiative.



**Delivering Healthcare Services at Doorstep** 

SRMS Mobile Telemedicine Bus - It is equipped with basic diagnostic facilities and free pharmacy with video conferencing facility through which specialist doctor at SRMS telemedicine studio provides consultation and prescribes medicines. This bus is visiting every day except Sunday to the rural areas and delivering medical services. This facility was inaugurated by Honorable Health Minister of UP, Shri Siddtharth Nath Singh Ji in September 2017. Since then 86694 patients have been benefitted by this initiative.

SRMS Janhit Chikitsa Yojna - The programme was inaugurated on

constraints. Under this scheme Trust has provision for selecting 6 patients every day and provide treatment to these patients in its hospital. During the treatment the patients are provided free of cost medicines, consumables, food, investigation and hospitalization. The annual budget of 50 lakh is allocated under this scheme. Total 799 JCY patients have been provided free indoor treatment in 2019.

**SRMS** Samudayik Swastha Yojna - It provides provision at Rs. 365/- per year (Rs. 1/- per day) for treatment upto Rs. 50,000/- for the couple in SRMS Hospital. Under One Rupee scheme total registered 20713 till now. 1639 patients have been treated in year 2019 and cost borne by the Trust in the treatment was around Rs. 1.3 Crore.



Free Medicine Distribution

Free Pharmacy - at SRMS hospital, providing 150 types of generic ethical medicines and consumables including 5th generation antibiotics to OPD and IPD patients. Around 1000 + patients are taking medicines every day. 3 Other free pharmacy outlets are being run by SRMS Trust Village Dhaura Tanda, village Bhairpura and Rampur Garden, Bareilly. Total 2.25 lac prescriptions have been honored for Rs. 1.5 Crore in year 2019.

Cataract Screening and operation programme - The Trust has undertaken this programme since 2nd Oct. 2002. Till date the Trust has organized 1000+ Camps for selection of patients having cataract. More than 20000 patients have been successfully operated free of cost by the team of SRMS Doctors.

Rural Health Camp - The Trust organizes Rural & Urban Health Camps throughout the year and sends specialty and super specialty doctors in various medically backward areas for providing health care services. In these camps the Trust distributes free medicines and also provides free diagnostic services like ECG, Blood sugar and other basic Blood investigations. Till date the Trust has organized more than 1000+ Camps and examined over 50000 patients.

Government Health Programmes / Schemes - The Trust is also running various Govt. Sponsored Health Programmes in its Hospital, such as – Revised National Tuberculosis Programme (DOTS), Govt. recognized MDR-TB testing lab for 8 districts, Janani Suraksha Yojana, Free Sterilization, Family Planning & Welfare Programmes, Vaccination Programme, ICTC Centre for AIDS and Ayushman Bharat - PMJAY. SRMS Hospital has also been recognized by Prime Minister's National RelieffUND AND cm funds for Cashless treatment of poor patients.

**Telemedicine Centre at village Bhairpura** - A Telemedicine Centre has been established in village Baharpura District Bareilly in which the patients are diagnosed by the doctors after video conferencing with specialty and super specialty doctors present in studio of SRMS Hospital, Bareilly. The medicines are also given free of cost since 2015, 53000 patients have been benefitted by this initiative.

Under this programe to Cochlear Implant Surgery every year are being done free of cost by the Trust.

Teaching methodology has been designed to inculcate conceptual and technical skills in students and is based on lectures, demonstrations, seminars, group discussions, practical training on patients etc. Efforts have been made to impart education and training through a methodology consisting of -

**Teaching Aids-** Modern scientific teaching is practically impossible without a gamut of teaching aids viz. overhead projectors (OHP), slide projector, LCD projectors, computer and internet, power point presentations etc. Our faculty utilizes these facilities liberally.

**Lectures -** Didactic lectures are delivered by experienced faculty to give an overview of different organ systems.

**Laboratory Demonstration** - These are held in the respective labs according to prescribed syllabus to develop psychomotor skills, ability to observe, verify and to reach on logical conclusions.



**Clinical Demonstration -** Clinical Demonstrations are given with an objective to develop technical skills in the students and to illustrate how to perform an act procedurally.

**Clinical Teaching -** Students are sent to the various wards and departments for developing better skills and have a direct interface with the patients which enables them to improve their nursing care, techniques and skills.

**Teaching through simulators -** Skill development lab has been developed considering the need for teaching through simulators. Here the trainer exposes the students for conducting specialised procedures on live like simulators before practicing on patients. A demonstration of various organs, nerves & senses given to the students through sophisticated software fitted mannequins.

Tests and Viva-Voce - Regular written/Practical/Viva-voce tests are taken to revise and reinforce the knowledge,

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**Tests and Viva-Voce** - Regular written/Practical/Viva-voce tests are taken to revise and reinforce the knowledge, hitherto imparted to assess student's ability and effort in understanding the subject.

**Group Discussions -** These are held periodically in batches of 6-10 students, supervised by a faculty facilitator for clarifying doubts, sharing knowledge with fellow colleagues and teachers.

**Panel Discussion -** This training programme helps the students to be confident and gain the update knowledge. It provides a broad platform to the students to nurture their talent.

**Symposium -** Symposium is a type of socialized technique







where as each of participants is expected to present a well reasoned argument or point at view the respect to the problem being discussed.

**Workshop-** A workshop is a meeting during which experienced and experts people to find the solutions of the problem and try to remove the work errors. This training programme helps to reach the aim of educational point and it improves learning activities.

**Student Tutorials/Seminars -** These include Assignments, poster making, write-ups, short orations to inculcate the spirit of self learning.

**Problem Based Learning -** We have also introduced problem based learning in batches of 6-10 students with an expert facilitator from the faculty.

**Field Trip** - These are organized to give the students training in natural environment by making them visit special departments, units in the hospital, outside agencies and community services.

**Student Development Programme-**The student development programme is organized for students over all development to enhance his/her communication skill, grooming, presentation and knowledge.

### Laboratories

**Nursing Foundation Laboratory -** Without a solid foundation one will have trouble creating anything of value. Our air conditioned Nursing Foundation lab enables the students to gain adequate knowledge regarding basic procedures through which the firm foundations of the fundamentals of nursing will be laid down. To nourish the foundation our spacious lab is well suited with patient many simulators on which students will be taught the preliminary training of patient care.

Pre-Clinical Science Laboratory - Pre-clinical Science lab provides comprehensive knowledge of microbiology, anatomy, physiology and biochemistry. This lab is designed with excellent infrastructure, equipped with various specimens, models, slides and charts. Therefore, the students can have more understanding related to the structure and physiological process of various organs and systems of the human body. This lab also helps in developing deeper knowledge and skills among the students which will help them applying it on clinical and theoretical grounds.

**Nutrition Laboratory** - Nutrition lab facilitates learning by providing the faculty and students with the settings, models, equipment and supplies necessary to develop skills regarding nutritious diet for a patient. Our college has state of art nutrition lab with all modern amenities for teaching therapeutic diet for the patients. Students get excellent training in nutrition and dietetics during their course of studies.







### Laboratories

Computer Laboratory- Our air conditioned computer lab is well suited and designed with latest computers with world class software enabling the students to match the pace of the world around them. All computer units share local area network.

Advance Skill Laboratory- The advance skill lab aims at teaching and training students the essential advance nursing skills to provide overarching care for adult patients suffering from variety of disease conditions. It prepares nursing graduates qualified in the care of the adult patient according to the highest standards of nursing care. This lab also provide hands on learning experiences specific to course objectives as directed by the nursing curriculum.

Community Health Nursing Laboratory-Community Health Nursing lab is a miniature of community setting be it be a rural or urban. It is a stimulated home environment that allows nursing students to practice their community health skills in a life like scenario. Our CHN lab is therefore an extension and expansion of the ideal guidelines of nursing. It has all the necessary measures, equipments that will thereby help our students to face any challenges in the community.

**MCH Laboratory-** Maternal and Child Health lab provides comprehensive knowledge and it focuses on training of all the essential skills required to work and perform as able midwives. The infrastructure of lab is designed to help the students to learn the maximum within the four walls making all the necessary equipments and articles within their reach to later function well as a paediatric nurse or a midwife.









### **Merit Scholarships**

Shri Ram Murti Scholarship Late Shri Ram Murti ji was a great source of inspiration for the students particularly the meritorious but economically weak. Therefore the Trust decided to offer financial help to economically weak but meritorious students from the day of its inception. Initially such help was limited to only 10+2 and undergraduate students (1990). Later on such scholarship was extended to the students pursuing professional, technical, medical, nursing courses in institutions run by the Trust. The year 2007 was the turning point when Trust decided to distribute Scholarships of RUPEES THREE CRORE each year to meritorious students of institutions run by the Trust.



## Teaching & Training Hospital

(1000 Bed Multi Super Speciality Hospital)

Shri Ram Murti Smarak Institute of Medical Sciences has most modern 1000 bed, centrally air-conditioned, Multi Super Speciality, Tertiary Care and a Trauma Hospital established on 4th July' 2002. The Hospital has 500 teaching beds for teaching & training of students pursuing MBBS, Nursing & Paramedical. The treatment of the patients on these beds is done free of cost. The Hospital is well equipped with facilities to provide quality teaching & training to the students in various departments. Students during their clinical training are exposed to variety of patients so as to make them competent in the field of medicine. During their training students are also exposed to behavioral & managerial skills required in today's world for becoming a complete medical practitioner.





The hospital is proud to have trust in the society in providing quality medical care to the patients coming from Bareilly District and nearby districts in a radius of 250 kms, adjoining state Uttrakhand and adjoining international border of Nepal. The hospital is running various programmes of National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) like Free Cataract Surgery Programme under DBCS, Free deliveries under Saubhagyawati Matratva Suraksha Yojna, Tuberculosis Programme under RNTCP, Leprosy Programme, Child Immunization Programme, Family Planning Programme and others. The hospital actively participates in cause for Polio eradication.

#### Casualty

The Hospital has a 24 hrs Casualty ward and has expertise in Trauma Management with an expert team of physicians & surgeons. It has the facilities of 20 beds, Treatment Room, Minor OT & Major OT Complex with all necessary equipments for handling emergency like Ventilators, Cardiac Monitor, Mobile X-Ray, Pulse Oxymeters, Defibrilators, ECG machines etc.

#### O.P.D.

The OPD is planned in a modular pattern with each department having Consultation Chambers, Reception, Waiting Area, Case Demonstration Room and other necessary laboratories and clinics as required in each department. The OPD timing is from 9.00 am to 2.00 pm and the consultation with the Doctors is free of charge.

#### Inward

The hospital has five-tyre ward building having 400 free beds for the department of Medicine, Paediatrics, Psychiatry, TB Chest, Dermatology, Surgery, Orthopaedics, ENT, Ophthalmology & Obs. & Gynaecology. Further the hospital has centrally air-conditioned Surgical ICU, Medical ICU, ICCU, NICU, PICU, Semi Private Ward, Private Wards & Deluxe Wards. All Wards have nursing stations, Doctor Duty Room, Pantry, Teaching Area, Examination Room, Toilets for patients & staff and sufficient waiting hall for attendants.



#### **Critical Care**

Critical Care Medicine department is a 20 bedded critical care unit, with nurse to patient ratio of one, for patients on ventilators and those requiring invasive monitoring. Its two main objectives are excellence in Critical Care and training of future specialists in critical care medicine. A didactic training program based on the core curriculum for trainees in Critical Care Medicine complements extensive clinical experience. To achieve its goals, the department is rich with following facilities:

- 24 hours X 7 days Consultant Critical Care Supervision.
- Advanced monitoring system for Cardiac Hemodynamics including Flow Trac, Respiratory, Neurological and other factors of homeostasis.
- Protocols of critical care formulated and implemented as per ISCCM & ESICM guidelines.
- Bed side Arterial Blood Gas Analysis.
- Facilities for imaging i.e. X-ray, Ultrasonography, Echocardiography, Peripheral Doppler.
- Haemodialysis (including CRRT), Endoscopy and Video-Bronchoscopy at bedside.
- Microprocessor controlled ventilations to provide ventilatory support to both adults and children.

#### **Advanced Imaging Center**

With the acquisition of the latest state-of-the-art 256 Slice (128x2) Dual Source Siemens Somatom Definition Flash CT

Scanner, our hospital has added a feather in its cap as only 4 other such machines exist in the country. The equipment from Siemens was installed in the month of September, 2011.

The following are the advantages of this machine

- Coronary Angiography (in 1 Second)
- Cerebral Angiography
- Peripheral Angiography
- Triple phase Liver studies
- Perfusion studies of Brain, Liver etc.
- Characterisation of Renal Stones
- Virtual endoscopy, bronchoscopy
- Lower radiation to the patient as compared to older machines
- Faster scanning time
- Increased diagnostic accuracy due to Multi planer Imaging

The Department also undertook a study on Liver ARFI

(Acoustic Radiation Force Impulse) values in Indian population in the month of November. This study is invaluable in assessing patients of Liver diseases such as Cirrhosis of liver. Purchase of Siemens Acuson 2000 USG Scanner is being planned for this purpose.

#### R.R. Cancer Institute & Research Center

Ram Rakhi Cancer Institute & Research Centre (RRCI & RC) had a humble beginning on 30<sup>th</sup> September 2008. Functioning under the auspices of Radiotherapy Department, it is equipped with High Energy Linear Accelerator with Multi-leaf Collimators and 30 channel HDR Selectron Brachytherapy equipment with Allenger's C-arm.



The department is providing state of art Radiotherapy treatment techniques like 3D-CRT for various cancer patients. Besides this, there is an exclusive ward with well-trained nursing staff for giving chemotherapy. The mission of this Cancer Institute is to develop a comprehensive protocol based cancer treatment to all the patients with the support of different clinical departments especially ENT, gynecology and General Surgery.

The department is also focused to make general awareness in public about prevention of this deadly disease. Starting with 2 patients a day, the Department now is treating more than 40 patients every day in a very short span of 3 yrs. RR Cancer Institute is the second such institute in Uttar Pradesh and Uttrakhand, providing state of the art facilities in the field of cancer.



## Cath Lab

The cardiac catheterization laboratory is busiest department in the hospital and has emerged as a premier centre delivering an extraordinary range of clinical and research services to patients suffering from a variety of cardiovascular ailments with a goal of providing the best cardiovascular care.

The system of established standard protocols, rigorous attention to minute details and strong sense of teamwork has helped us to achieve the best interventional outcomes in this region. We have continued to improve our outcomes each year, with unprecedented extremely low procedural complications in 2010-2011. This remarkable growth has been achieved despite high case complexity and incidence of comorbid medical

## **Hospital Services**

#### **Blood Bank**

The institute also has the facility of BLOOD BANK for providing blood to the patients. Our Blood Bank is running 24 hours for the benefits of the patients. The Blood of all groups is available in Blood Bank for the patients. Automatic coagulation analyser for coagulation profile is already functional. Soon various blood components like PRBCs, Platelets, FFPs etc. would be available.

#### **Pharmacy**

There is round the clock pharmacy where practically all types of quality medicines of good reputed companies are available at a very reasonable price. The trust runs a 'Free Medical Shop' for patients where WHO prescribed drugs are provided free of cost.

#### **Ambulance Services**

SRMSIMS provides round the clock ambulance services to critically ill patients. The ambulances are fully equipped with gadgets for cardiac monitoring, invasive and non-invasive BP monitoring and ventilator support. An ICU trained Doctor, nurse and healthcare assistant accompany the patient during the transit period.

#### C.S.S.D.

The Hospital has a Central Sterilization Department having vertical & horizontal sterilization machines that caters to all the requirements of Wards, OPD's, Casualty and others.

#### Central Gas Plant

Hospital has a Central Gas Plant which supplies Oxygen, Nitrous Oxide and Air through Central Pipe LIne to all the wards, OT, I.C.U., N.I.C.U., P.I.C.U. and Emergency.

#### **Animal House**

To obtain authentic results of the research experiments and test, it is important to have standardized animal with known health and genetic status. The Animal House of the Institute provides optimum environment for experimental animals to be used for research under the care of a Veterinary Doctor.

#### Mess

The Hospital has Central Mess which provides special and normal diet to the patients and to the hospital staff at very concessional rates. The Mess maintains a high level of Hygiene while preparing & serving the

meals. A special lift has been provided in the hospital to transport the meals to differnt wards.

#### Laundry

Hospital has a fully Automatic Laundry catering to the need of wards, patients, Doctors, students and staff.







## **Operation Theatre**



The Hospital has a Central ten O.T. Complex and separate two O.T. Complex for Gyanecology. The Theaters are well equipped with equipments such as Micro-scopes, Modern O.T. Light, C-ARM, Laproscope & Endoscope for all kinds of Laproscopic and Endoscopic Surgeries. It has a wide range of instrumentation to carry out simplest to complex surgeries. There is a separate sterilization Unit for O.T.

# IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS!

1- Ragging is completely forbidden and is punishable as per the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

Ragging is punishable offence under Law

As per the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court, State Government and U.P. Technical University ragging has been declared illegal and is completely prohibited and banned. any student caught or informed by victim student or his parents/guardians, an F.I.R. will be lodged against the student involved in ragging.

The following action will be taken:

- (a) Registration of F.I.R. against student involved in ragging.
- (b) Immediate expulsion from the college/hostel.
- (c) Every victim or his/her parents/guardians of raging can also file an F.I.R. directly with the police.

The college has taken following steps:

- (a) A proctorial board has been constituted.
- (b) An anti-ragging cell has been set up.
- (c) A standing committee has been constituted.

So, keep away from any activity amounting to any kind of Ragging.

- 2- Timing Timings are from 8.00 AM to 4.10 PM. Special class timing for weak students upto 5.30 PM. Students are not permitted to enter the institute campus after 8.15 AM and not allowed to leave the campus before 4.10 P.M.
- 3- Parents are advised not to give any two-wheelers or four wheelers to their wards for coming to the institute, it leads to conjestion and leads to accident by reckless driving.
- 4- Badge Each student will be provided with an identification badge with his / her photo and name as well as other details on it. The students have to compulsorily wear ID badges inside the campus and in institute buses. Without ID badges they are not allowed to enter the campus. ID badges has to be worn by the students during visit to other institutes / universities for participating in sports, cultural and other academic activities.

- 9- All requisition applications for Bonafide certificates, scholarship form should be addressed to the Principal. The Trust scholarship




form should be addressed to the Managing Trustee.
